Overview

ABSTRACT

Vital Statistics are derived from information obtained at the time when the occurrences of vital events and their characteristics are inscribed in the civil register. Vital acts and events like the 2004 marriages are recorded in the civil register at the Local Civil Registry Office (LCRO). These administrative documents underwent processing, controlling, compilation and analysis.

The 2004 Vital Statistics report on marriages provides information on the number and percent distribution of marriages recorded, the place and month of occurrence, crude marriage rate, daily average and daily index of marriages by month of occurrences, age distribution and nationality of brides and grooms by place of occurrence, type of ceremony and others.

The data collection was done through a registration method/system as mandated in Act 3753 (i.e., all vital events that marked the entry and departure of a person in his lifetime and the changes in his/her civil status shall be registered).

Data Processing

Data Editing

The processing of this vital documents are done at the Local Civil Registry Office (LCRO) and the National Statistics Office (NSO). Data editing/verification and quality control were done in various stages of Civil Registration System:

1. Registration of Marriages

1.1 The City/Municipal Civil Registrars (C/MCRs) are responsible on the proper and complete registration of marriages.

1.2 Solemnizing Officers from various religious sects and denomination are also required to assist in the reporting of the event for registration at the LCROs

2. Processing

2.1 The Vital Statistics Division (VSD) of the Civil Registration Department (CRD) at the NSO is responsible for the processing of the registered marriage documents. These includes completeness check , certification pass report, edit list report, and record list report.
