EXPLANATORY NOTES

Starting this year, 2008, the Bureau of Agricultural Statistics (BAS) is coming out with a quarterly situation report on four (4) major fruits, namely, banana, mango, pineapple and calamansi. These commodities are highlighted in the BAS quarterly report on the Performance of Agriculture. The quarterly report contains information on production, prices and trade. Data on area planted which is collected on a semestral basis will be reported during the second and fourth quarter issues.

Production data are based on the results of the quarterly Crop Production Survey of BAS. Data on prices are sourced from the BAS Farm Price Survey (FPS) and the Integrated Agricultural Marketing Information System-Agricultural Marketing News Service (AGMARIS-AMNEWSS). The report incorporates data on foreign trade which are obtained from the National Statistics Office (NSO) and organized by Agricultural Marketing Statistics Analysis Division (AMSAD) of the BAS. Due to the lag in their availability, export and import data may not cover the whole quarter being reported.

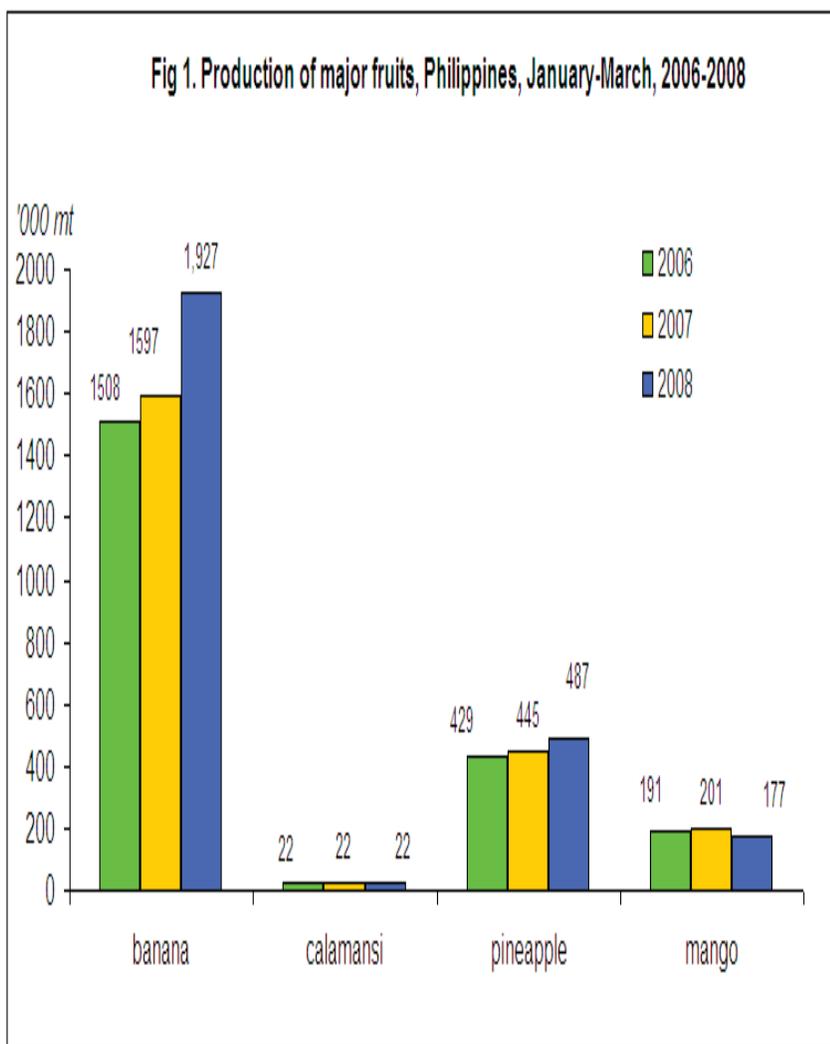
Production

Banana. Production for the 1st quarter of 2008 was estimated at 1,927 thousand MT, 20.65 percent higher than the 1,597 thousand MT in the same period of last year. The production increase was largely contributed by *cavendish* variety.

Cavendish production during the quarter reached 944 thousand MT or 49 percent of total banana production. The share of *saba* variety followed at 565 thousand MT or 29.5 percent. Output for *lacatan* variety was 198 thousand MT or 10 percent of the total banana

production. This expansion was primarily the result of steady growth in the cultivated area due to rising local and export demand especially in *Davao Region*. The Davao-based corporate farms started to harvest from their newly opened areas in *Northern Mindanao*. At the same time, other producing regions recovered from the 2006 typhoons resulting in higher production levels.

Pineapple. Production for the 1st quarter of 2008 stood at 487 thousand MT, only 42 thousand MT or 9.36 percent higher than the year ago level of 445 thousand MT. Increasing demand from both local and export markets coupled with the recovery from the effects of 2006 typhoons resulted in higher production levels. *SOCCSKSARGEN*, *Northern Mindanao* and *Bicol* were the main contributors to the increased output level.

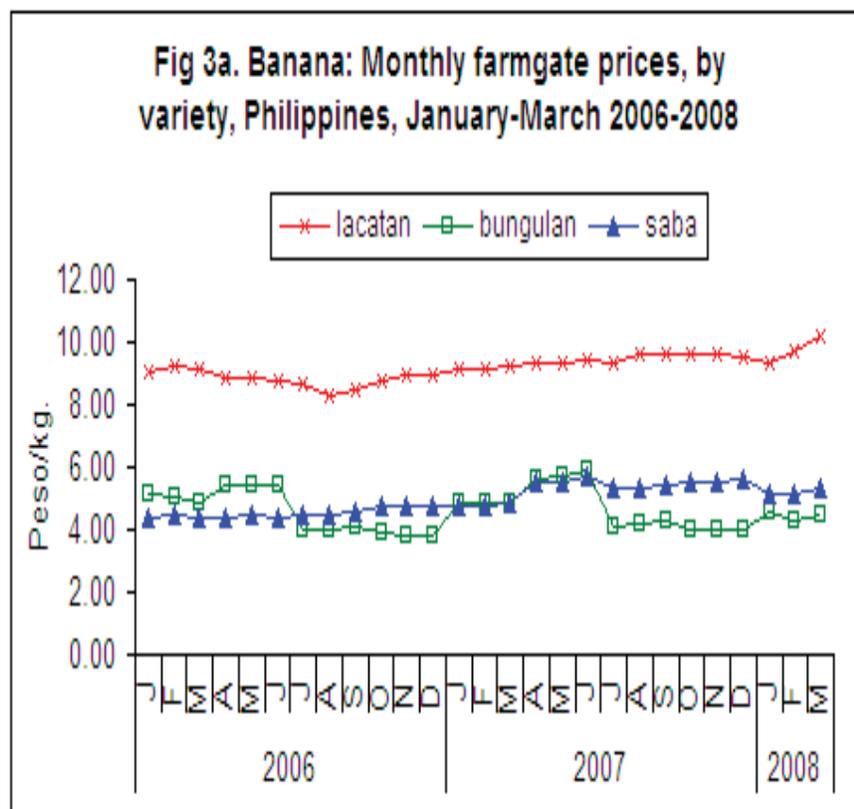


Mango. The first quarter 2008 production was estimated at 177 thousand MT, lower by about 24 thousand MT or 12.06 percent compared to the 1st quarter production last year. Of the total production, 84 percent or 148 thousand MT were *carabao* variety, while 4 percent or 7 thousand MT were accounted for by *piko* variety. This shortfall was due to adverse weather conditions that affected bearing trees during flowering stage. Because of continuous rains and strong winds in the major producing regions of *Ilocos*, *Central Luzon* and *Western Visayas*, there was a reduction in bearing trees artificially induced.

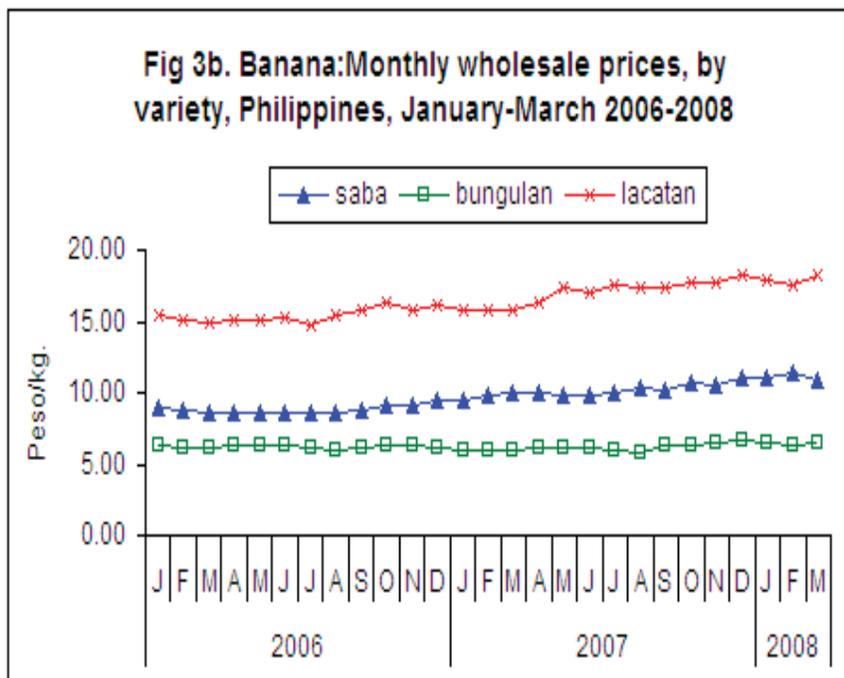
Calamansi. Total output during the quarter stood at 22 thousand MT, 0.47 percent higher than the level in the same quarter a year ago. The increase was attributed to fertilizer use and adequate soil moisture. Also, *MIMAROPA* which contributed more than half of calamansi output reported an increase in the number of bearing trees.

Prices

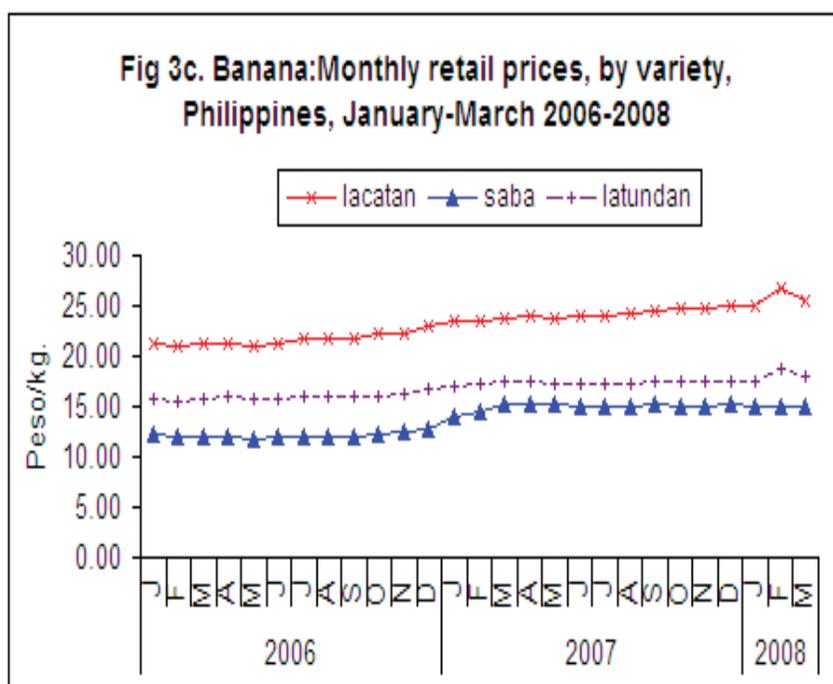
Banana. During the first quarter of 2008, the average farmgate price of *saba* was P5.21 per kilogram. This was higher by P0.43 and P0.80 compared to their respective 2007 and 2006 averages. The average price of *lacatan* was recorded at P9.75 per kilogram, up by P0.54 and P0.62 from its corresponding prices in 2007 and 2006. For *bungulan*, average farmgate price was P4.43 per kilogram, lower by P0.43 and P0.58 from its 2007 and 2006 levels.



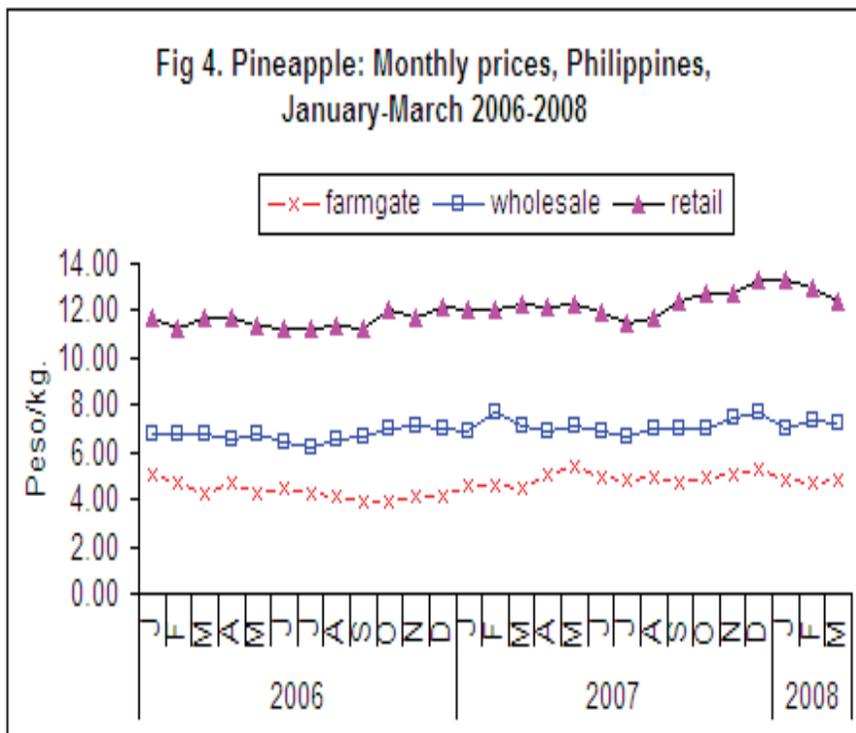
At wholesale, *saba* sold at P11.07 per kilogram, on average. This was higher by P1.26 and P2.28 from its respective prices in 2007 and 2006. Prices of *lacatan* also increased by P2.07 and P2.79 against their 2007 and 2006 levels. Average price of *bungulan* was also higher by P0.37 and P0.16 compared to its 2007 and 2006 levels.



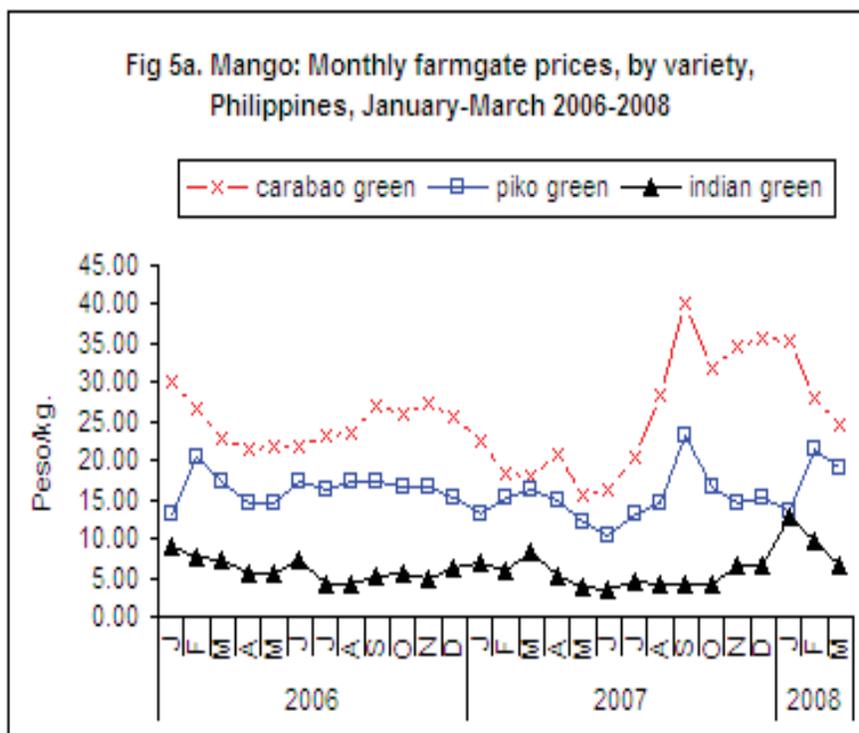
Retail price of *saba* averaged P15.09 per kilogram. This was higher by P0.57 and P3.00 from the 2007 and 2006 prices. Average price of *lacatan* was up by P2.10 and P4.56 against prices in the same period of 2007 and 2006. Compared to the first quarter a year ago, average price of *latundan* was also higher by P0.80 per kilogram.



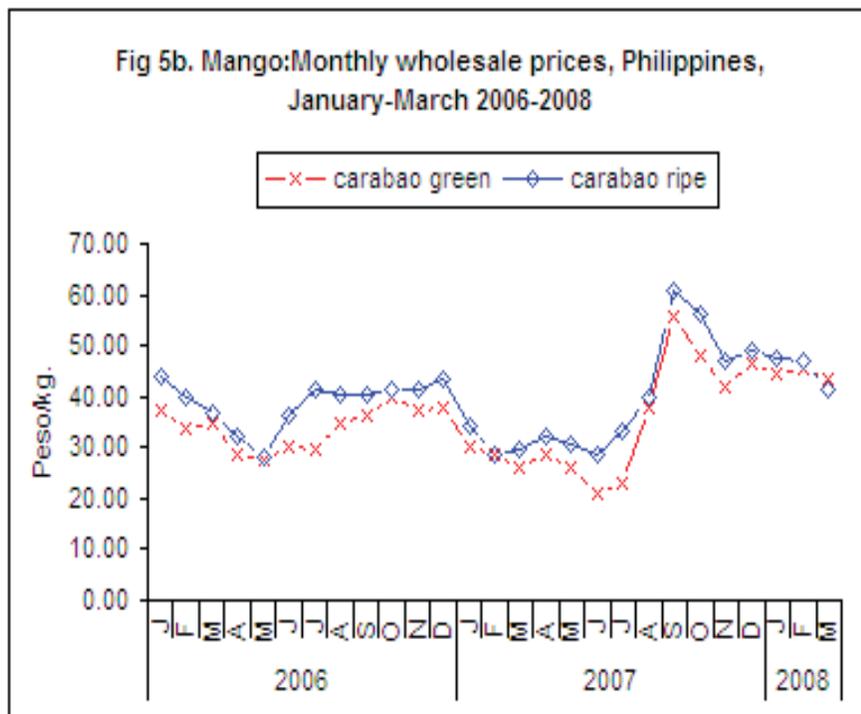
Pineapple. The January to March 2008 average farmgate price of pineapple was P4.79 per kilogram. This was higher by 5.43% and 3.38% from 2007 and 2006 prices, respectively. However, average wholesale price of pineapple went down slightly by 0.87% from last year's level. Average retail price stood at P12.89, higher by 6.3% from last year's price.



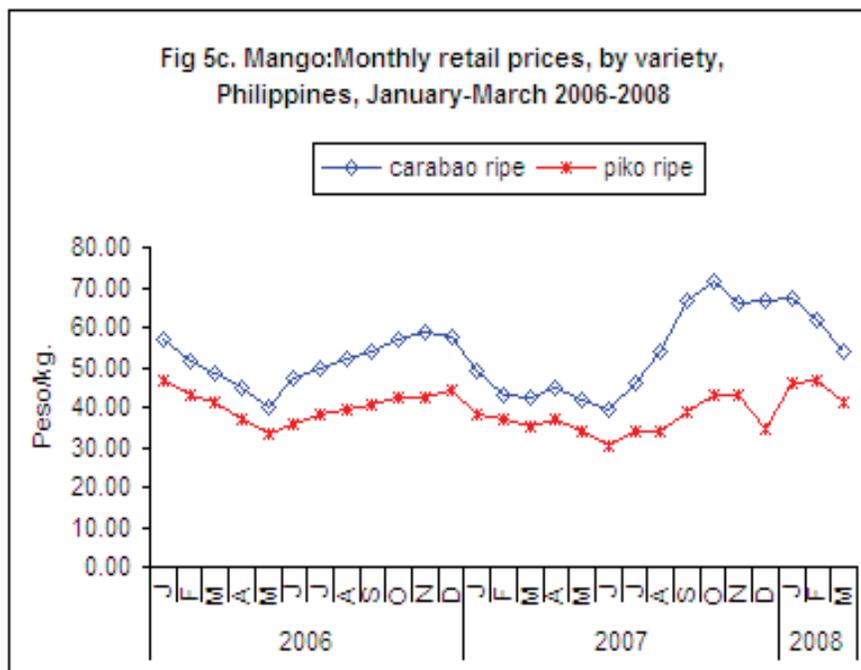
Mango. Average farmgate price of *carabao, green* was P29.38 per kilogram, posting a significant increase of 49.67% from its 2007 level. Average prices of *piko* and *indian* varieties also increased by 20.66% and 36.92%, respectively.



At wholesale, average price of *carabao, green* also increased by 56.61% and 26.28% from their respective levels in 2007 and 2006. Likewise, average price of *carabao, ripe* moved up by 48.09% and 13.45% from 2007 and 2006 prices, respectively.



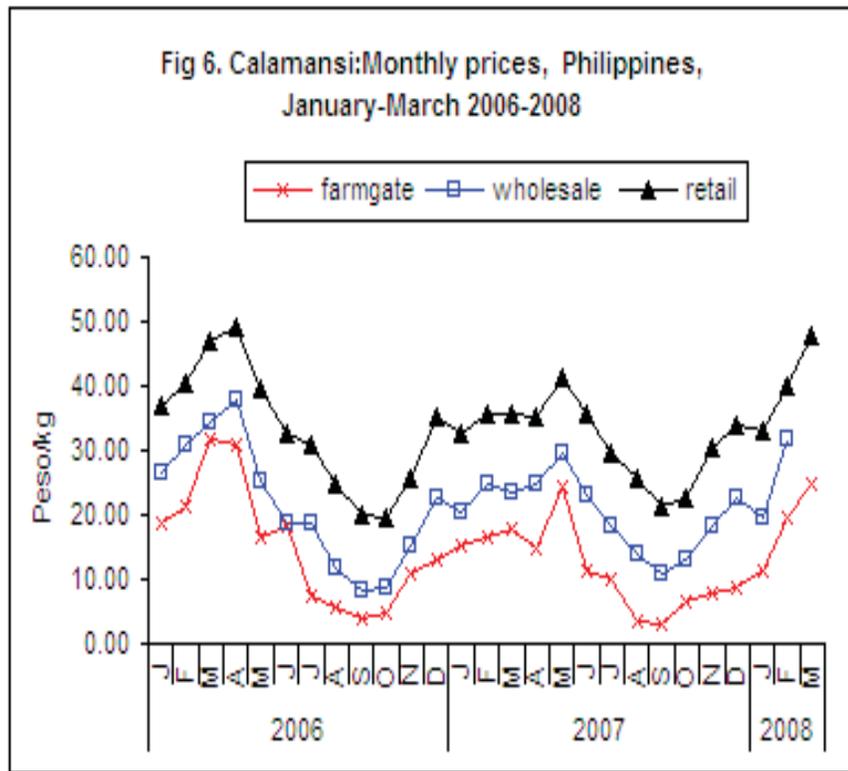
Average retail price of *carabao, ripe* was P61.11 for the first quarter of 2008. This was higher by 36.34% and 16.87% from its respective levels in 2007 and 2006. Average price of *piko, ripe* also increased by 18.8% and 21.16% from 2007 and 2006 prices, respectively.



Calamansi. Average farmgate price was recorded at P18.57 per kilogram during the 1st quarter of 2008. This was 12.12% above last year's price but 22.08% lower than the 2006 price.

At wholesale, average price went up by 30.93% from its 2007 level.

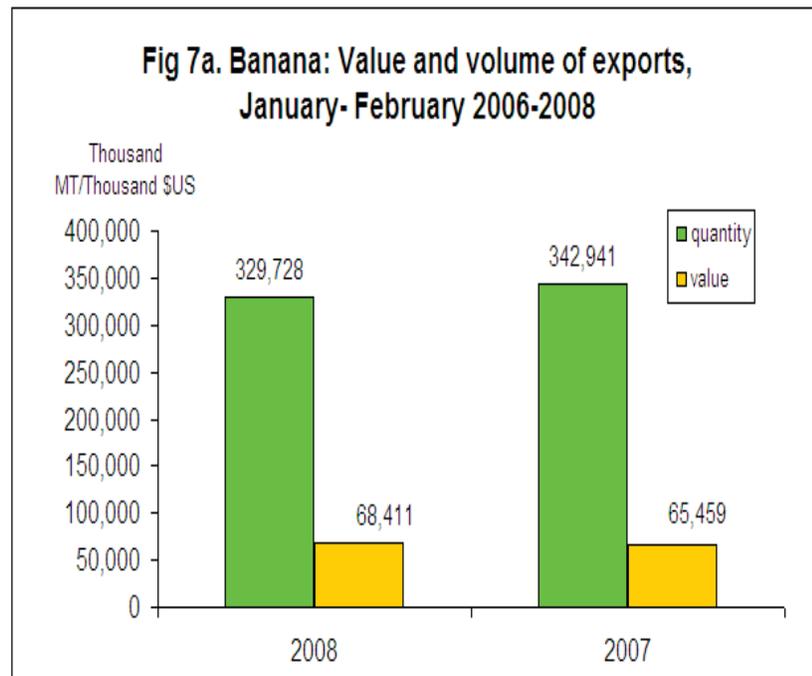
Retail price increased by 15.88% against its 2007 level.



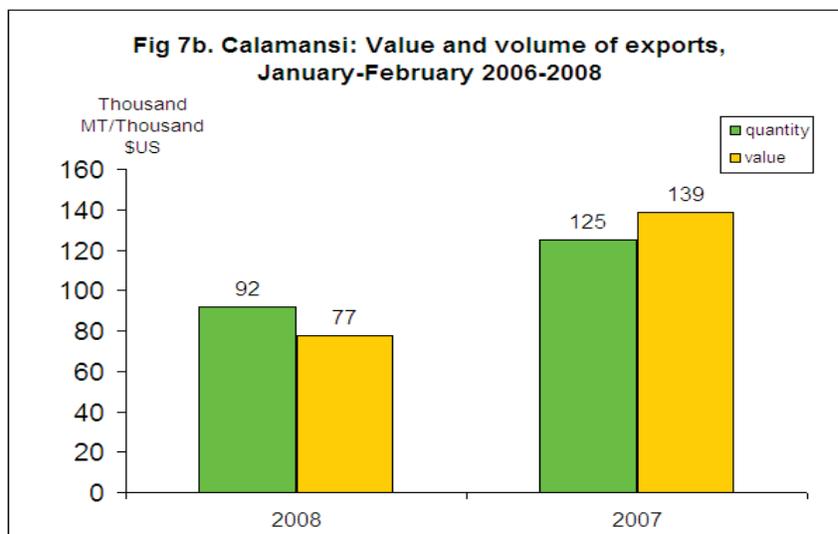
TRADE

EXPORTS

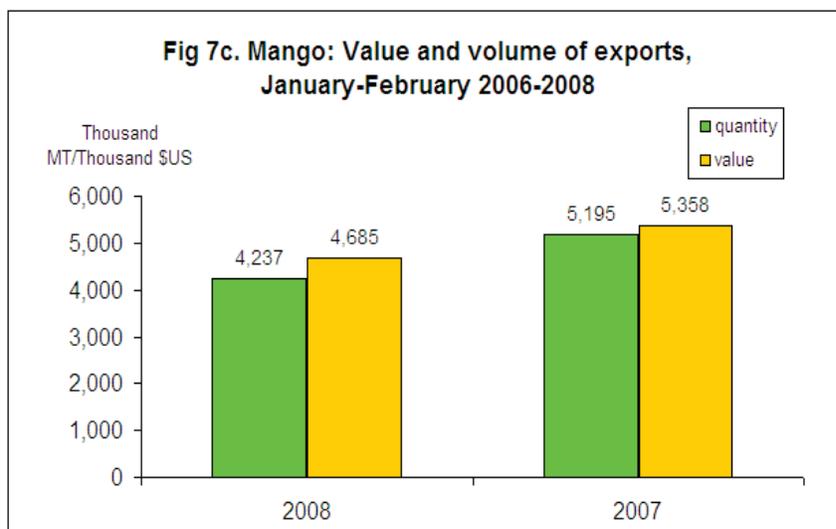
Export receipts from banana during the period January to February 2008, went up by 4.5 percent or from US\$ 65.5 million a year ago to US\$ 68.4 million this period. However, at 329.7 million MT volume of shipments fell by 3.9 percent compared to the same period last year which was 342.9 million MT.



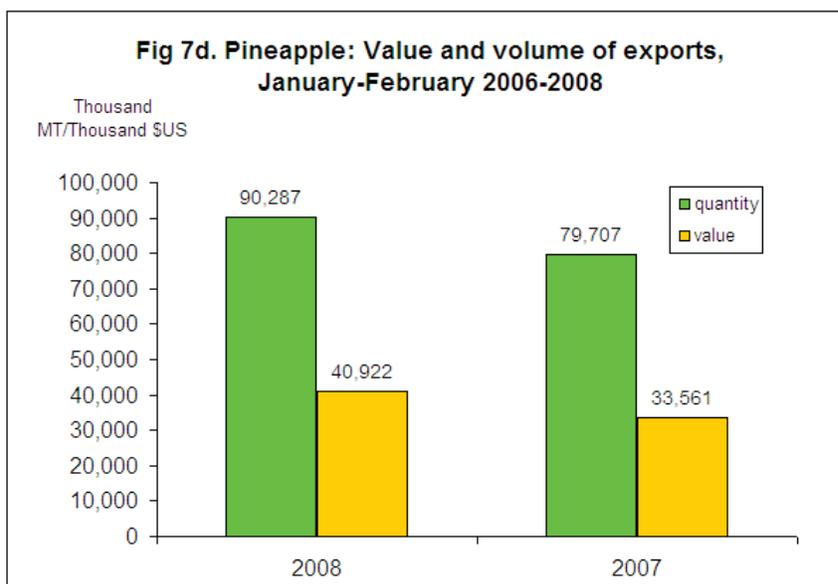
Calamansi exports from January to February 2008 amounted to US\$ 77.5 million. This was lower by about 44.2 percent compared to last year's US\$ 139 million. Likewise, volume of export slipped by 26.3 percent compared to last year's level. From the recorded 124.8 million metric tons in 2007, export dropped to 92 million MT in 2008.



Mango exports had a negative growth during the January to February 2008 period. From the export receipts of almost US\$ 5.36 million in 2007, it went down to US\$ 4.69 million in 2008. Similarly, the total volume exported at 4.24 million MT was down by 18.44 percent from last year's level.

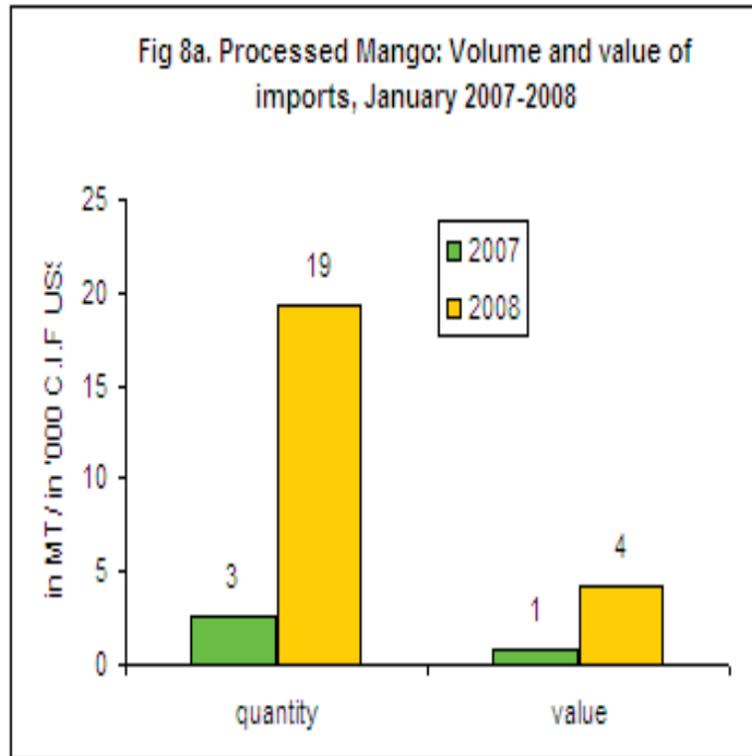


Total revenues from pineapple exports amounted to US\$ 40.9 million, registering a 21.9 percent increase from last year's level. From 79.7 million MT, exports rose to 90.3 million MT in 2008.

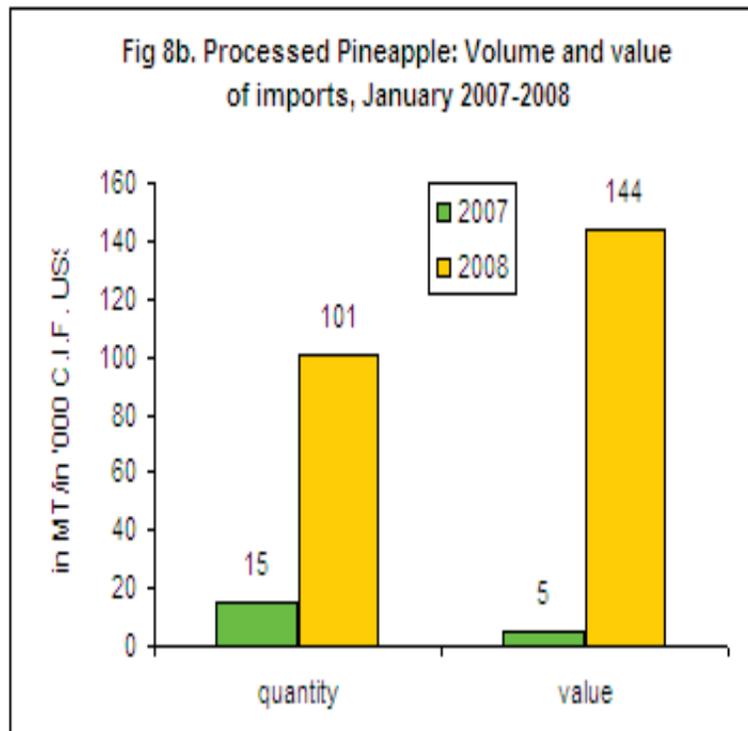


IMPORTS

Total value of mango imports for the month of January 2008 posted a significant three digit growth (381.44%). From last year's US\$1 million, imports jumped to almost US\$4 million during this period. The *Republic of South Korea* supplied all of the US\$ 4 million worth of mango products coming in the country. Total volume of imports in 2008 and 2007 were 3 MT and 19 MT, respectively.



Pineapple exhibited a similar trend. Imports increased by more than 2,800 % compared to importation last year. Total value of imported processed pineapple amounted to US\$144 million in 2008. Almost half of the total volume of pineapple imports in the country were sourced from *Taiwan*.
