SUBJECT: Third Run of the Pilot Survey of Broiler Farms in Regions I, III, IV-A and X.

This has reference to the pilot survey of broiler farms using the new questionnaire. The survey was initially conducted last July 2008 in Regions III and IV-A. The review of survey results noted that data generated were still inadequate. In order to generate the needed data, the survey questionnaire was revised and the 2nd run of the pilot survey was conducted in January 2009 in Regions III, IV-A and X. Results of the 2nd run already showed substantial requirements in terms of data adequacy and quality of responses. Another survey will be conducted in these regions including Region I in April 2009. This round intends to sufficiently transfer the technology of regional summarization, validation and basic analysis using both the manual procedures and the newly developed electronic processing system. Attached herewith are the following:

1. Revised Broiler survey questionnaire (CLPS Form 7)
2. Provincial Summary Worksheets (Form 1-PSW) and Regional Summary Worksheet (Form 2-RSW).
3. Supplementary guidelines on accomplishing the questionnaire
4. Guidelines on manual consolidation/summarization of results and generation of output tables

Provincial summary and validated results (consistent with the time series RDR/NDR estimates on broiler inventory and disposition) shall be submitted to the ROC two (2) days before RDR for regional consolidation. The ROC shall consolidate, summarize the results and generate regional output tables subject to RDR deliberations. Moreover, the ROC shall incorporate validated results in the NDR worksheets and shall prepare narrative report with basic analysis of the supply-disposition and destination of broiler in the region including issues and problems encountered during operation. Regional summary, output tables and narrative report shall be submitted to LPSD, Central Office thru SOCD on or before the National Data Review.

All expenses incidental to this activity shall be charged against BAS GMA-Livestock Funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
