SUBJECT : **Conduct of the 2003/2004 BLES Integrated Surveys
and 2004 Occupational Wages Survey**

DATE : **May 19, 2004**

BACKGROUND:

1. The Bureau of Labor and Employment Statistics will be conducting joint survey operations for the **2004 Occupational Wages Survey** (OWS) and the **2003/2004 BLES Integrated Survey** (BITS). This is to rationalize data collection activities for the purpose of providing our users with **an integrated data set on key labor and employment indicators**.
2. The OWS is a nationwide establishment survey that focuses on employment and wage rates (hiring/entry and actual rates) of time-rate workers on full time basis in selected occupations in selected non-agricultural industries. It also inquires on the distribution of time-rate workers across basic pay and allowance intervals.
3. The BITS, now on its second run, also a nationwide establishment survey, contains key data requirements for the study of industry trends and practices and the formulation of policies on employment, conditions of work and industrial relations.
4. The conduct of the OWS and BITS are mandated under EO 126 (creating the BLES), which mandates the BLES to conduct nationwide surveys and studies which will generate trends and structures on labor and employment. Further, EO 352 designates OWS as one of the statistical activities that will generate critical data for decision-making of the government and the private sector. The data category average monthly occupational wage rate of selected occupations is also one of the variables listed by the Philippine government under the Special Data Dissemination Standard (SDDS) of the International Monetary Fund. The SDDS serves as reference to member countries in the dissemination of economic and financial data.
5. Field operations for these surveys shall start on July 5, 2004.

6. The number of establishments covered by both surveys are as follows:

OWS only	4,452
BITS only	2,864
Common to both	4,327
TOTAL	11,643

Of this total, **5,033 establishments are located in NCR while 6,610 are located in regions outside NCR.**

7. For this purpose, the BLES will hire a total of **70 Project-Based Individuals** (piece-rate) as field enumerators to undertake data collection and field editing in NCR. The BLES shall also hire, through the DOLE Regional Offices, (except NCR) a total of **159 Project-Based Individuals** to undertake supervision, data collection and field editing in regions outside NCR.
8. The amount of **P 4.116 M** has been allocated for the nationwide conduct of these surveys. Of this amount, **P 2.435 M** shall be provided to the DOLE Regional Offices (except NCR) as interfund transfer.
9. Results of these surveys will be available by June 30, 2005.

The BLES will be conducting simultaneously the 2003/2004 BLES Integrated Survey (BITS) and the 2004 Occupational Wages Survey in July this year. This is to rationalize data collection activities for the purpose of providing our users with **an integrated data set on key labor and employment indicators.**

For this purpose, all Regional Offices, (except NCR) in behalf of the BLES, shall hire Project-Based Individuals (PBIs) to conduct field operations for these surveys in their respective areas based on the attached Work and Financial Plan. The recruitment of PBIs should be completed by June 25, 2004 to allow sufficient time for training and distribution of workload in time for the start of field operations on July 5, 2004.

Interfund transfer shall be facilitated by the Financial Management Service and executed in favor of the regional offices not later than the third week of June 2003 to defray expenses for the survey, including those incurred for the two-day briefing on field operations. The DOLE-ROs should liquidate this interfund transfer not later than the end of November 2004.

A briefing on field operations for the BITS and the OWS shall be conducted by the BLES for concerned regional staff at the **Occupational Safety and Health Center in Quezon City on June 17-18, 2004.** In this regard, may we request for the names of at most two (2) of your staff who will be assigned to directly supervise survey operations, preferably your statistician and economist. For this purpose, we have attached the duties/responsibilities of the regional supervisors. We would appreciate receipt of their names **on or before June 4, 2004** through Ms. Susan Vargas at telephone nos. 527-3419/527-9324 or Ms. Nancy Dimapilis at telephone nos. 527-3489/527-9325.

- a. Participate in the training on data collection and field editing to be conducted by BLES;
- b. Conduct training to Area Supervisors and Enumerators;
- c. Ensure the implementation of the survey in their regions within the allotted time;
- d. Allocate questionnaires for delivery to field personnel, receive and control questionnaires from the field and send to BLES within the required period the spoilage/retrieved/verified questionnaires and those questionnaires for endorsement to NCR head offices, covered by the applicable transmittal forms;
- e. Check the completeness and consistency of the entries in the accomplished questionnaires and return those for verification to Area Supervisors or Enumerators;
- f. Deliver questionnaires if necessary, conduct follow-ups, spot checks and verification;
- g. Submit the regional report on the implementation of the survey and other required reports to BLES;
- h. Monitor and evaluate the performance of field personnel for purposes of determining the survey status and payment of salaries; and
- i. Ensure the confidentiality of data provided by the establishments.
